PHI PHI KAPPA ALPHA CLUB

The ΦΦΚΑ Club was established as a special annual giving society to provide undergraduate brothers the opportunity to invest in their own chapter through the Pi Kappa Alpha Foundation while still in school. All donations to the ΦΦΚΑ Club are applied to the Chapter Endowment Fund of the respective donor.

Individuals may join by making a \$25 annually renewable donation while they are an undergraduate. Chapters may receive a discount of \$5 per person if every member of the chapter joins together at one time. Chapters who join as a whole receive recognition at all PIKE U events they attend. Chapter awards are also presented each year at The Academy or the International Convention.

CHAPTER ENDOWMENT PROGRAM

A Chapter Endowment Fund for each chapter is held at the Pi Kappa Alpha Foundation and is designed to benefit each chapter specifically. Gifts received through the ΦΦΚΑ Club or any gift designated by a donor to the chapter will be added into the respective Chapter Endowment Fund. Grants from each Chapter Endowment Fund are issued to the chapter's PIKE *University* scholarship fund after the fund reaches endowment – currently \$10,000. In keeping with the Foundation's mission and its obligations as a 501(c)(3) organization, awards from each Chapter Endowment Fund are limited to scholarships for attendance at educational programs of the Fraternity (e.g. Chapter Executives Conference, The Academy, Pike *University* Leadership Summits).
